We hereby certify that all applicable electrical and electronic equipment placed on the EU market comply with European RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances) Directive 2011/65/EU and its subsequent amendments as of **4 MAR 2026**. Homogeneous materials of parts that are compliant with this legislation have less than 0.1% by weight each of Pb, Hg, Cr(VI), PBB, PBDE, DEHP, BBP, DBP and DIBP, and 0.01% by weight of cadmium (Cd). In situations where an exemption applies, the preceding limits, corresponding to the exempted substance(s), may be higher. Products are CE marked in accordance with Directive 2011/65/EU and supported by a formal EU Declaration of Conformity.

We hereby also certify that **Zeido Technologies, LLC** products do not contain Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) as listed on the current ECHA Candidate List in concentrations exceeding 0.1% w/w per article, in accordance with Article 33 of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 of the European Parliament and of the council concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization, and Restriction of Chemicals (REACH) and are deemed compliant per the ECHA SVHC list (as listed on the current ECHA Candidate List at the time of this declaration).
